
## COUNCIL IS RESPONSIBLE FOR 975KM OF ROADS



Did you know?

- Current research establishes that funding maintenance at a rate of \$50,000 per km over the life of a road extends the life of that asset from 10 to 15 years to over 30 years.
- But, If the above maitenance funding is not provided the life of a road can decline and more significant repair will cost aproximately \$1.2m per km.
- Lithgow City Council has a backlog of road renewal and reconstructions. What does this mean?
  - All our maintenance funding is spent keeping rapidly deteriorating roads in a serviceable state.
  - but a backlog of more significant works is building.
    Without intervention, this backlog will become unaffordable.
  - Sufficient funding is required to close the backlog. Once this is achieved we can incrementally increase preventative maintenance year on year.
